





PBS member station, PBS Reno, serving northern






One day in class, I find myself looking out the window at the waves and I wonder what it will be like to live on the moon.

My name is Carl, and my parents are looking for a new house in Hawaii.




First, I go to get some builders to help me build my house on the moon. Then I will tell them about my idea.
